

## 4th Quarter YTD Significant Variance Explanations

The Village of Machesney Park Intergovernmental Agreement for Building Services was terminated during the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2018 (October 2017 - December 2017). Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for building inspections with the City of Loves Park. Also, there is an overall decrease in the permit volume from 2017 to 2018 year-to-date due unusually high numbers resulting from storm damage that occurred in 2017. Project Quickstart building permit has been processed for the development at Rock 39 corridor in the Village of Cherry Valley.
