The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office is currently testing for position of Corrections Officer. The successful applicant will be placed on an eligibility list to perform the duties and responsibilities of a Corrections Officer.

Must present Driver's License or State ID

(Comfortable clothing such as sweatshirt or t-shirt, shorts or sweat pants and gym shoes should be worn.)

Upon successful completion of the physical agility and written testing, applicant will be issued a Corrections Application which is to be completed and returned to Corrections Administration, 650 West State Street, Rockford, IL 61102

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1) Must be a citizen of the United States
- 2) Must be 21 years of age
- 3) Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent
- 4) Must possess a valid driver's license upon which the applicant may legally operate a motor vehicle in the State of Illinois.
- 5) Must not have been convicted of a felony nor any other crime which would prevent the applicant from attending a certified academy for basic police training under the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et seq.) or which would prevent the applicant from legally possessing a firearm.

Applicants must successfully pass the following examinations:

- 1) Physical Agility Test
- 2) Written Test
- 3) Background Investigation
- 4) Psychological Assessment
- 5) Medical Examination

PHYSICAL ABILITY ASSESSMENT TEST

After completing the initial application, the next step in the testing process is the successful completion of the physical ability assessment test. This consists of three (3) separate events that will determine an applicant's fitness level, as compared to a standard, 1.5 mile run, sit-up and push-up test.

It is recommended that each applicant prepare for the series of tests, as the physical agility assessment center is the first step in the process of securing employment as a Winnebago County Corrections Officer. An applicant who fails any of the three (3) events will be eliminated from the testing process.

Below is an explanation of the events.

The minimum standard must be met in order for an applicant to continue in the testing process.
