WHEREAS, competitive bids for 18B-2123 were received in the Purchasing Department on February 15, 2018 for Winnebago County for the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of the County of Winnebago, Illinois that a contract be issued to Sjostrom & Sons, Inc., 1129 Harrison Avenue, Rockford, IL in

the amount of \$119,100.00 for the base contract plus the cost of moisture mitigation and a 10% contract contingency.

Subject: Juvenile Detention Center Security Electronics Systems Upgrade

The Winnebago County Juvenile Detention Center is requesting approval to expend funds totaling \$184,845 for a security electronics and wiring at the facility. There are three components to this project.

1. Upgrade the touch screen and controller units
2. Replace the Dukane intercom headend equipment.
3. Replace and add cameras within the facility.

Justification

The current touch screens and computers which control them are in need of replacement. The operating systems are outdated and the computers have gone down repeatedly over the last two years. The service technician for Stanley indicates that they need to be replaced and upgraded to avoid ongoing problems and/or a total shutdown where they cannot be restored in a short period of time. Without the touch screens staff will have to carry and use keys which then makes it possible for a minor to overpower the key holder and escape from the facility.

The Dukane Company which manufactured our intercom is no longer in business and parts for the intercoms are difficult if not impossible to obtain. The intercom is the only way for the minors to communicate from their room with the control room operator in the event that they are in distress or need assistance. The intercom also is used by the police and others to obtain access to the building and so it is an integral part of the safety and security of the facility. The upgrade will ensure that the aging system is replaced with a new unit which can be repaired when it breaks.

The request to add and replace cameras is being made in an effort to eliminate blind spots in the facility. The Detention Center is required to comply with the Federal Prison Rape Elimination Act. Compliance will require the addition of cameras so that video evidence to either prove or disprove complaints of sexual contact which are filed by a minor against either the staff or another minor. The facility has waited as long as possible to make this request but as other detention homes in the State are complying with the Act, and being certified after the required inspections that they are in compliance, waiting longer is not an option.

Background:

The Purchasing Department went out for Bid #18-2123 in February for the Juvenile Detention Center Remodeling Project.

There were a total of six bidders, with Sjostrom & Sons Inc. being the lowest responsible bidder (See Bid Tab). The decision is to go with the base contract amount plus the cost of moisture mitigation and a 10% contract contingency.

Recommendation:

Sjostrom & Sons has worked successfully in the past on County projects. The architect for the Juvenile Detention Remodel Project, Richard L. Johnson Architects also recommends the award.

Therefore, it is recommended that Sjostrom & Sons, Inc. be awarded a contract for Bid #18B-2123.
