Re: Winnebago County Board of Review

This memo is to inform interested individuals residing within Winnebago County, that pursuant to the political makeup requirement specified by state statute (35 ILCS 200/6-15¹), a new Winnebago County Board of Review member will need to be appointed for the 2021 property tax assessment year. Per the results of the last general election², this individual needs to be affiliated with the Republican Party.

Letters of interest will be accepted from January 18th, 2021 to February 18th, 2021 and should be addressed to the attention of the Winnebago County Chairman, Joe Chiarelli at 404 Elm St. #533, Rockford IL, 61101 or by email at Joe@Wincoil.us.

Pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/6-10, individuals wishing to serve on the Winnebago County Board of Review must pass an exam proctored by the Illinois Department of Revenue with a score of 70% or greater prior to the appointment. Please see the following information regarding the exam:
