Summary of Responsibilities

Under direction of the Animal Services Director or the Kennel Supervisor cleans and sanitizes kennels, and cares for all impounded animals to prevent and control disease. Vaccinates and medicates sick animals. Following established criteria performs euthanasia. Maintains and prepares records and files and reports.

Illustrative Examples of Work

- 1. Cleans and sanitizes the kennels.
- 2. Vaccinates and medicates sick animals.
- 3. Following established criteria performs euthanasia.
- 4. Responsible for care and feeding of animals to prevent and control diseases.
- 5. Maintains records and prepare reports as required.
- 6. Inventories medications, anesthetics, disinfectants and animals housed in the facility,
- 7. Performs all duties in accordance with County policies and procedures.
- 8. Performs other duties as required or assigned.
- 9. Regular attendance is required, overtime as needed/scheduled.

Education and Experience

- Requires completion of four years of high school or general education diploma.
- Requires one year of experience in an animal related field.
- Requires knowledge of safety practices concerning the handling of animals.

Abilities

- Requires excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to perform euthanasia both physically and emotionally.
- Requires the ability to remain calm and decisive under stressful situations. Requires the ability to establish priorities under critical timelines.
- Requires the ability to prepare a complete and accurate/detailed records and reports.
- Requires ability to establish and maintain satisfactory working relationships with fellow employees and the general public.
- Must be available and able to work various shifts, including nights, holidays, and weekends; work on an on-call basis; work irregular job assignments.
- Requires ability to move up to 75 pounds.
- Requires preventive rabies vaccination.
